

Wayne County Grand Slam Tournament Rules

August 17-18, 2013

Cash prize winners may be subject to a polygraph/voice stress test, including captains of the kids' cash prize categories.

A grand slam will consist of three out of five species of the following: catfish, pan fish, mudfish, largemouth bass and gar. To be considered a Grand Slam, a team must have caught at least three of the five species.

Entry fees must be received by August 13, 2012 before the late charge is assessed. After that date, only cash or online registrations will be accepted. Registration will be accepted at the tournament site on August 18th. Prior disqualifications prevent participation in this and any other tournament event.

1. All state and federal laws and regulations will be observed. Any infraction of these laws and regulations will result in disqualification. It is the responsibility of the entrant to be familiar with these laws and regulations.
2. Tournament hours: 12:00 p.m. Saturday, August 17 to 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 18.
3. Boats must be at weigh-in by 2 p.m. Sunday, August 18.
4. Fish may be caught by any legal means. Limit of one setline (ie. Bush hook) per person. Line must be tagged and removed before weigh-in.
5. Flags must be displayed while anchored. If fishing out of the boat, you must be within 150 feet of the boat.
6. Only one fish of each species will be weighed in.
7. Any fish weighed in as kids fish or females fish must be designated as such prior to weigh in.
8. All children 16 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult.
9. The tournament committee will decide ties and disqualifications.
10. An optional captain's meeting will be held Saturday, August 17, at 10:00 a.m. at Jaycee Landing for any questions or concerns regarding the tournament or its rules.
11. Winners will be determined at the close of the tournament.
12. Any protest must be made 30 minutes of weigh-in to weigh masters
13. Any contestant with a blood alcohol content high enough to affect the outcome of the polygraph test will be disqualified by tournament committee.
14. Waters open to the tournament include the Altamaha River and its tributaries downstream of the confluence of the Ocmulgee & Oconee River in which you have permission to fish.
