

Wayne County Grand Slam Tournament Rules August 20 & 21, 2016

Cash prize winners may be subject to a polygraph/voice stress test, including captains of the kids' cash prize categories.

A grand slam will consist of three out of five species of the following: catfish, pan fish, mudfish, largemouth bass and gar. To be considered a Grand Slam, a team must have caught at least three of the five species.

Entry fees must be received prior to fishing. After August 19, only cash registrations will be accepted. Registration will be accepted at the tournament site on August 20th. Prior disqualifications prevent participation in this and any other tournament event.

1. All state and federal laws and regulations will be observed. Any infraction of these laws and regulations may result in disqualification. It is the responsibility of the entrant to be familiar with these laws and regulations.
2. Tournament hours: 12:00 p.m. Saturday, August 20th to 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 21st.
3. Boats must be at weigh-in by 2 p.m. Sunday, August 21st. Weigh in hours are Saturday until 10pm and Sunday 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
4. Fish may be caught by any legal means. Limit of one setline (ie. bush hook) per person. Line must be tagged and removed before weigh-in.
5. Flags must be displayed while anchored. If fishing out of the boat, you must be within 150 feet of the boat.
6. Only one fish of each species will be weighed in.
7. Any fish weighed in as kid's fish or female's fish must be designated as such prior to weigh in.
8. All children 16 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult.
9. The tournament committee will decide ties and disqualifications.
10. Winners will be determined at the close of the tournament.
11. Any protest must be made 30 minutes of weigh-in to weigh masters in writing along with a protest fee of \$50.
12. Any contestant with a blood alcohol content high enough to affect the outcome of the polygraph test may be disqualified by the tournament committee.
13. Waters open to the tournament include the Altamaha River and its tributaries downstream of the confluence of the Ocmulgee & Oconee River in which you have permission to fish.
14. All fish weighed in are property of the tournament.
15. **Tournament T-shirts must be picked up during tournament or at weigh-in.**
